

Uniform Agreement



Student/Parent Agreement:

Uniform: It is an integral part of our school requirements to wear the school uniform correctly. It is also part of the enrolment policy of the school and parents have been advised of this during the enrolment process.

Application: The consistent wearing of the school uniform by students is important. In the interests of maintaining a standard that avoids competitiveness among students and/or a decline in the general appearance of the uniform it is necessary that specific details are adhered to.

Teachers have been asked to supervise the appropriate wearing of uniform and it is also expected that parents will supervise and take responsibility for their children having the correct uniform on each day.

Student Expectations: (Also see uniform requirements attached)

- 1.) Students are expected to wear the correct uniform at all times.
- 2.) Students are to wear a hat for all outside activities, including, recess, lunch, sport & excursions in Terms one and four. Sport in Passmore Centre or Undercover area is exempt. Students sitting in the sun at lunch or recess time, must have a hat on in Terms one and four.
- 3.) Secondary students are to wear correct footwear. (See shoes acceptable/not acceptable sheet attached) Students not wearing correct footwear will be sent to the office and their parents contacted.
- 4.) White, Black or Navy Blue undergarments are to be worn and are not to be visible through the school shirt or hanging out the bottom or arms of school shirt. No coloured undergarments are to be worn.
- 5.) Jewellery wearing is not permitted, except simple sleepers or studs. (Studs are to be small in size) **NO SPACERS** will be acceptable or any other body piercings.
- 6.) All nail polish is to be removed.
- 7.) No makeup is to be worn at school. (This includes foundation)
- 8.) Socks should meet requirements attached. No brands to be on any socks. Socks are to be folded at just above ankle height.
- 9.) Surf Brand, Skate Brand, Volleys, Vans or cheap slip ons are not permitted.
- 10.) Hair below shoulder length must be tied back. Hair must be **natural in colour and tidy**. (Hair should not be coloured other than a child's natural colour) Hair ties and hair accessories must be black or navy blue.
- 11.) School uniforms should not be ill fitting, faded, torn or disheveled in nature.
- 12.) No stealing of other peoples hats.

Consequences of failure to meet the above requirements:

- 1.) Form teachers/class teachers will be overseeing the correct wearing of the school uniform.
- 2.) If uniform is not correct a letter will be sent home, and it is expected that the issue will be rectified immediately. If the letter is not successful parents will be contacted by telephone.
- 3.) If students are wearing incorrect socks a letter will not be issued, new socks will be provided and cost will be put on an account.
- 4.) If failure to wear the correct uniform is a continuing occurrence, students will be required to go to the office. Parents will be required to come and collect the student, or bring them the correct uniform or authorize the office to purchase the correct uniform, before the student will be able to return to class.
- 5.) If hair colour, length or tidiness is deemed by the school leadership team to be unsuitable the students parents will be contacted and the situation rectified before the student will be allowed to continue on at school.

Students out of school grounds must be in full school uniform or out of school uniform completely.

It is a school requirement that students representing Bethel are neat and tidy.
